We are spring cleaning our Work in Progress list on the BAHS Web site, and we invite you to review your entry. It may be up to four years since you created your entry and we are sure that you want it to reflect your current interests.

Please go to [www.bahs.org.uk](http://www.bahs.org.uk) and navigate to your entry (via **Work in Progress > List**). At the bottom of your entry, there is a link to **Create, Update, or Delete your entry**, which opens in a new window or tab so that you can see your entry and the form at the same time. You have *four* choices: to leave the entry as it is, make minor changes, update it (fill in the whole form again) or have the entry deleted.

Since the list first appeared online, we have let you choose whether or not to have your email address listed. You need to be aware that you may receive 'spam' (unexpected email from someone you don't know) if your email address is listed on a Web page. If you have received spam, please accept our apologies. Always be suspicious of clicking on links or file icons in an unsolicited email.

We still provide an explicit opt in/opt out question on the form about publishing your email address.

If you choose not to publish any contact details from now on, we will do our best to forward any correspondence that arrives for you via our contact forms, but due to BAHS resource limitations can't guarantee to do so.

We have made some changes to the Work in Progress form: most importantly we no longer ask for your postal address.

We plan to make the spring-cleaning of the Work in Progress list an annual event.
